ORDER REINSTATING MASK REQUIREMENT FOR STATE COURT

As a result of the rapidly increasing hospitalizations from COVID and the status of Houston County showing 99 cases per 100,000 with a 14-day increase of 76 percent as of today, the Court determines it necessary to mandate any person attending State Court in Houston County to wear a mask. All persons must wear a properly fitting mask over the mouth and nose in all State Court courtrooms, assembly areas, and chamber areas. This Court specifically finds such a mandate is essential to the effective functioning of the adjudicative process and will remain in effect until explicitly revoked.
